

## CRE\_ICHEAR OMOZ2016 Travel Grants

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The CRE\_ICHEAR is a national research collaboration that brings together leading researchers and Indigenous health care providers from around Australia to improve ear and hearing health of Indigenous children. The CRE\_ICHEAR is dedicated to high quality innovative research, promoting Indigenous leadership, and effective and sustainable research translation. The CRE\_ICHEAR is funded by the National Health and Medical Research Council (NHMRC) from 2014-2019. The CRE\_ICHEAR aims to inform Australian policy and practice to reduce social and educational disadvantage linked to childhood ear disease and hearing loss.

### Travel Support Program

The CRE\_ICHEAR offers travel support for researchers to attend OMOZ2016. Consideration will be given to relevance to CRE\_ICHEAR related research, and whether full or partial support is requested. Support will cover registration, plus up to \$500 towards travel costs.

Priority will be given to:

- Applicants who are presenting an abstract at OMOZ 2016 (please attach proof of abstract submission).
- Applicants who have secured additional funding for the conference &/or are self-funding their attendance.
- Students and researchers working within the CRE\_ICHEAR.
- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people studying or working in the field of ear and hearing health.

### Requirements

The CRE\_ICHEAR OMOZ Travel Grant requires that all successful applicants:

- Acknowledge and publicise the Grant received from the CRE\_ICHEAR when presenting.
- Submit a 1-page report within 1 month of completing their proposed travel, detailing the outcomes of their participation and what the benefit was to the applicant
- Complete a reimbursement claim and provide a tax invoice(s) within 1 month of completing their travel.
